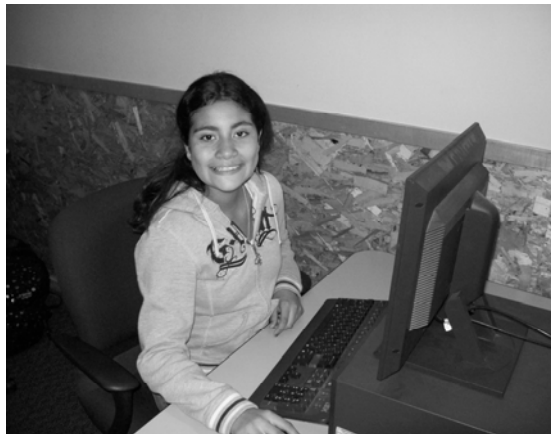
To Parents, Mentors and Members,
